**CRIPPLE HILL, HIGH HALDEN, ASHFORD**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cripple Hill, High Halden, near Ashford.**

**A closure is planned from Monday 9 March 2020, with estimated completion by 13 March 2020.**

**Cripple Hill will be closed in the general vicinity of Ramstile Farm, with local access from either direction up to where the road is closed.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via Shawlands Lane and A28 Ashford Road.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**

**There is a chance that the planned dates may alter, and updated information can be found on one.network – [South East Water Permit EB006-20410716], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
